"We're seeing great success from the work we are doing to help stroke survivors. Our Community Stroke Advisors team support survivors and their families by developing plans to achieve the best possible outcome after stroke. Over the last quarter we saw that on average, 70 per cent of our clients achieved their goals through this initiative. Stroke affects 9,000 New Zealanders each year – that's one every hour – and there's an estimated 60,000 stroke survivors living in New Zealand. This figure is projected to increase by 40% in the next decade. Further donations will support our work and enable us to help more people across the country."
